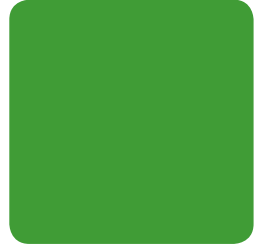

There's a youthful momentum in Tulsa fueled by professionals that want it all – entrepreneurial opportunities, personal and professional growth, and work-life balance. The TYPros program creates networking opportunities for over 8,000 of the under-40 set. TYPros leadership is dedicated to assisting existing business and industry growth through on-campus recruiting at local colleges and universities. The group

also delivers presentations to employer groups that are recruiting and hiring young professionals. The TYPros.org website provides an online gathering place for these connected professionals to network and learn about their community.

TALENT DIVIDEND NETWORK

Tulsa's potential is vast. We're working to tap into that "talent dividend," and further develop the existing workforce right here at home. The Talent Dividend Network is a national group of cities sharing best practices to increase the number of college degrees, credentials and certifications in their metro areas. We host Adult Enrollment Blitzes and partner with local post-secondary schools offering fast-track programs to help Tulsa's talent grow. A one percentage point increase in college degrees obtained in the Tulsa region would result in an economic impact of \$646 million annually, bringing companies more than just a larger high-quality talent pool to hire from.

Oklahoma Scholars and College Access Career Readiness give Tulsa Public Schools students the foundation they need to succeed after graduation. Oklahoma Scholars sets students on a
